# Fire Dept. / Bldg. & Zoning/Inspectional Services - Chief Mickil Smith

Report Submitted: From 9/1/20-10/13/20 – Total Calls 389, Fire related 60, EMS 299 and Other 30. Inspections 236. October is Fire Prevention Month. Information will be noted on website. There will be a new eligibility exam on 10/24 10am at George Patton School. Alley Project is nearing completion. Fire Department received 2 grants one for \$56,000 from FEMA AFG (Assistance Firefighter Grant) to cover new extrication equipment and Arcellor Mittal for \$5000 for thermal imagining cameras.

### Public Works - Jerome Russell

Report Submitted for month ending 10/13/20. Director Russell stated he's pricing road salt. Cargill stated that road salt will cost approximately \$86.00/ton and Central Management Services informed us their cost would be \$50.00/ton. The sewage pumping station at 134<sup>th</sup> and Halsted has damaged float control valves. We're looking at cost for repair. ComEd will be out this month cutting down ash trees that are adjacent to power lines. Notice will be given to residents to access their property for this purpose. In month of September street sweeper was out every day. No failing test of drinking water. Public Works responded to over 200 Julie Locates during September most for new gas main and service line installation.

### Police Department - Chief David DeMik

Report Submitted: Month ending 10/13/2020 Chief DeMik indicated 1/2021 Cook County is narrow banding the radio frequencies and the current radios will not work. Chief DeMik indicated he is researching grants to fund new radios. He stated he received a grant of \$5000 to go toward down payment for radios. Chief DeMik indicated speed bumps are being installed in various locations in town. This is a pilot program. The Department will be preparing a list for the Christmas food and toy giveaway. We are currently accepting applications for lateral police officers until Friday 10/16.

# Village Clerk - Karen Holcomb

Clerk Holcomb mentioned Early Voting starts 10/19. The closest places are Calumet Township at 12633 S. Ashland and Thornton Township 333 E. 162<sup>nd</sup> Street in South Holland. Handout with times and dates were made available.

# Village Attorney - Rich Bruen

<u> Hancock Engineering – Chuck Hodges</u>

Engineer Hodges stated IDOT is accepting applications for their Transportation Enhancement Program. 25% of their funding is set aside for communities with high needs. There is a cost share. Engineer Hodges says he'd like to prepare an application for submittal for the Street Scaping Program for 144<sup>th</sup> Street from State St – Tracy Ave past Metra Station. This would include new sidewalks (beautification program). Resolution is required. Applications are due 11/2. Will speak to IDOT representative regarding repair of Metra lot on southside of 144<sup>th</sup> St. On 9/11 inspection was done by Giorba Group on School Street bridge. A report will be provided to the Mayor. There were typical maintenance issues nothing major. Cost estimate for those repairs will be included in their report.
