A. Village Administration — Finance Director David Gonzalez

Working on next budget. He recommends a 5% water rate increase. Mayor Jackson mentioned implementing an ordinance whereby are

water rates would automatically adjust with Chicago's increases. Attorney Murphy acknowledged the request.

B. Building/Zoning Fire Department & Inspectional Services Fire Chief Mick Smith

The department had 181 calls, 85 fire related, 266 EMS calls. Medical Mondays will be resuming and applied for AFG grant for turn out gear.

C. Public Works — Acting Superintendent Todd Henning.

Street sweeper was out daily. Water main repaired at 13623 S. Wallace, 2 days of water sampling, 2 days of meter reading, 2 streetlights were repaired, 2 days of picking up debris from fly dumping. Repairs under way on pump drive at pumping station #1 as required by IEPA.

D. Police Department - Chief David DeMik

Chief DeMik is currently looking for funding for an upgrade for security cameras at the Public Safety Bldg. Administrative Commander Mike Weber started on 3/7 and has begun review of open detective cases. The Police Commission will finalize the initial Sergeant promotional list this week. 10 patrol officers have successfully completed the process.
