2. AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF RIVERDALE, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS AMENDING CHAPTER 5.02 OF THE RIVERDALE MUNICIPAL CODE (BUSINESS LICENSE REGULATIONS)

Mayor Jackson referred to Attorney Murphy he stated this ordinance eliminates the part of the business license regulations which permitted a payment plan for obtaining a license if someone was in violation of non payment of Village fees. That program will be eliminated. This ordinance will remove Section 5.02.185 from Village Code. There will be no payment plan.
